<b>RECYCLING GUIDELINES</b>			
<b>MATERIAL</b>	<b>WHAT CAN I RECYCLE NOW</b>	<b>PREPARATION</b>	<b>MATERIAL THAT CAN'T BE RECYCLED</b>
<b><u>GLASS</u></b>	Clear, brown, amber or green glass from food jars & beverage bottles	Rinse bottles and jars. <u>Do not break glass</u>	Broken glass, window glass, light bulbs, drinking glasses, ceramics, mirrors, tempered glass, Pyrex type ovenware
<b><u>ALUMINUM, STEEL AND BI-METAL CANS</u></b>	Aluminum, steel and/or bi-metal food cans, EMPTY aerosol cans, soft drink and beer cans, clean foil containers.	Rinse cans (crush if space is needed).	Aluminum siding, toys, lawn furniture, clothes hangers, paint cans, cans with food inside, greasy foil, scrap metals, screws, nuts, bolts etc.
<b><u>PLASTICS</u></b>  (PETE, HDPE, V, LDPE, PP AND PS)  <b>#1 through 7 stamped on bottom.</b>	Clear plastic milk, soda and water bottles, butter & cottage cheese containers, baby wipe containers, detergent, bleach & softener bottles/jugs, shampoo bottles.	Rinse, remove and discard lids in garbage (Crush bottles if space is needed). If container is greasy, wipe out with soapy water & rinse.	No styrofoam.
<b><u>NEWSPRINT</u> **</b>	Anything printed on newsprint paper (black or colored inks); phone-books & magazines	Place newsprint in a paper grocery bag, a plastic bag or bundle and tie. Place on top of recyclables inside bin **	If cart is full, DO NOT place newspapers outside of cart on wet days.
<b><u>CARDBOARD &amp; OTHER PAPERS</u> **</b>	Corrugated & pressed cardboard, cereal, shoe, tissue boxes; white office paper; magazines, ad inserts, junk mail including envelopes; paper bags	Place in a paper grocery bag, a plastic bag or bundle and tie. Place on top of recyclables inside bin **	Pizza boxes (place in garbage); waxed papers; hardback books; juice boxes; cardboard milk cartons; take-out food containers
<p>** If you must put newspaper, cardboard or other paper materials out in bad weather, place on top of recyclables in bin and close lid tightly to keep dry.</p>			
<b><u>RECYCLING REMINDERS</u></b>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Set out for collection the night before your scheduled day; place within 5-ft. of curb or roadside.</li> <li>2) Use prescribed container. If you have extra recycling call for a second recycling cart.</li> <li>3) Wet paper materials will not be collected. Place in trash the following week.</li> <li>4) Recyclables that are mixed with garbage will not be collected. Place in trash next week.</li> </ol>
